

CHESTER J. MILLETT, JR. OUTSTANDING TEACHER
AWARD

To be presented annually by the Abington School Committee to that teacher who by his/her performance has demonstrated a willingness to accept responsibilities and perform deeds well above those normally expected thereby distinguishing the teaching profession through great example, dedication, perseverance and commitment to helping students.

SELECTION PROCESS

A committee made up of representatives of the Abington Public School Principals, the AEA, and the PTO (two from each organization, one elementary and one secondary from the AEA and PTO) will meet in April each year to review resumes submitted in nominating a candidate. The committee will select one candidate whose name will be forwarded to the School Committee for confirmation. An application packet is available in each Principal's office and at the Superintendent's office. Nominations must be submitted by March 31 each year. The Assistant Superintendent for Pupil Personnel Services, will convene a meeting of the selection committee in April of each year. An application packet must be used for each nomination with all selections as complete as possible. Use only the space on the form provided under each criteria. Any additional pages will be disregarded. The School Committee will confirm the nomination at a spring meeting.
