Please be advised that the application and all required documents must be received by the Superintendent no later than the close of business, 3:00 PM on Friday, June 25, 2010. If the number of applications received exceeds the number of seats available, a lottery will be conducted.

Please note that the Abington Public Schools **does not** provide transportation for school choice students and that daily transportation of your child is your responsibility.
