

SUMMER SCHOOL ELIGIBILITY:

Abington Public Schools will offer summer school courses for students who have failed a subject and need to recover credit and/or complete a sequential course. To be eligible for summer school remedial coursework, students must receive a 50-59 final average for the year. Guidance counselors will notify students who are eligible for summer school. English I, II, III, IV

Grades 7-8:

Integrated Course

Credit is given from the school of enrollment, contingent upon successful completion of all coursework.

Purpose of the Program:

The purpose of the program is to provide remediation for students who need academic support or to recover credits for graduation requirements.

Because the coursework is concentrated, 100% attendance is mandatory. There is no opportunity for makeup work.

This program is self-funded. All courses must have sufficient enrollment to be offered.

Tuition is non-refundable.
