All athletes are prohibited from parking behind the Frolio School Monday-Friday before 6:00 p.m. This policy is in place due to an increase in student activity at the Frolio School after hours. Any athlete who violates this policy will be required to sit out the next scheduled game.

This application to compete in interscholastic athletics is entirely voluntary and is made with the understanding that the student has not violated any of the eligibility rules and regulations of Abington High School or the State Association. Further, the student and parent/guardian certify that they have read the section on Athletics contained in the Abington High School Student Handbook, and the student understands and agrees to abide by all the rules and regulations contained therein. The student also understands the penalties involved for violating these rules.

Athletic Accident Insurance: The Abington School Department provides accident insurance for pupils to participate in interscholastic athletics. The premium for said insurance is paid for by the Town. Each registered player, coach, or manager of an interscholastic sports team is covered for bodily injury while participating in or while under adult supervision to or from scheduled supervised interscholastic sports games or practice sessions. For the purpose of this insurance, interscholastic sports shall include the band and cheerleaders. This insurance coverage is non-duplicating inasmuch as it shall not include that portion of medical expenses resulting from any covered injury that is reimbursable by other valid and collectible insurance (i.e. BC/BS). It is the responsibility of the student to report an injury to the coach or adult in charge of the activity. An Abington Public Schools Accident Report will be filled out and filed in the High School office. The proper forms for filing an insurance claim must be obtained by the student or parent/guardian in the High School office. The student and parent/guardian have read and understand the above information relative to athletic accident insurance and agree to exempt and excuse the School Committee, individually and collectively, and any or all School Committee employees from liability in cases of school activity-related personal injury costs incurred by the above-named student.

The **parent/guardian hereby gives consent for the above-named student to:** represent his/her high school in athletic activities, provided that such activities are approved by the State Association, and accompany any school team of which he/she is a member on any local or out-of-town trips.

The parent/guardian authorizes the school to obtain, through a physician of its own choice, any emergency medical care that may become necessary for the student in the course of such athletic activities or such travel.

The parent/guardian also agrees not to hold the school or anyone acting in its behalf responsible for any injury occurring to the above-named student in the course of such athletic activities or such travel.

GUIDELINES FOR ATHLETIC/MARCHING BAND FEE

1. A \$250.⁰⁰ fee for Athletic/Marching Band and Color Guard has been established per student per sport (or marching band).
2. If a student or parent/guardian feels he/she cannot afford the fee, he/she may request a waiver by July 1 each year. Letters explaining the need for a waiver should be submitted to the Athletic Director or Marching Band Director. A committee to review requests will consist of the Superintendent, High School Principal and Athletic Director or Marching Band Director. Decisions will be made by August 1. If the committee determines there is a need, the committee will reduce or waive the entire fee.
3. The fee is non-refundable except for those students who are cut from any team by the coach in order to reduce the number of team members. Students who leave the team or band/color guard or who are removed from the team are not eligible for a refund.
4. Fees will be collected in the high school office between 8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. each day. All payments must be made by check or money order payable to the ABINGTON PUBLIC SCHOOLS' ACTIVITY REVOLVING FUND by July 15 for fall sports, Marching Band and Color Guard, October 1 for those students participating only in winter sports and February 1 for those students only participating in spring sports. Checks should include the name, address and telephone number of the student and Parent/Guardian. Receipts will be given for each payment.
5. Students may not report and equipment will not be issued until a list of participants has been finalized and on file with the Athletic or Marching Band Director, and the fee has been received. All payments must be in full; partial payments will not be accepted.
6. The playing time each participant receives is the prerogative of the coach or Marching Band Director. There is absolutely no assurance that each squad member will receive equal or any playing time.
